An eclectic man, he excelled as a swing piano player, church pianist and layman, guppy breeder, tomato grower, Boy Scout leader, and at being grandpa the mad scientist. He will be greatly missed by many. He was preceded in death by his wife Donna Sue (Todd) Washburne in 2002 and is survived by four children, Susan (David) of El Cajon, CA, Jane of Antioch, IL, Tom (Lynne) of Evansville, IN, and Jim (Lora) of Leesburg, VA, 15 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.
