Those candidates wishing to earn their first Amateur Radio License, or upgrade their present valid license, need to bring the following:

- 1. Any previously earned CSCE- original documents- if needed to prove that you passed an exam.
- 2. One copy of their current license and any CSCE if any.
- 3. Two forms of Identification, one bearing a recent photograph.
- 4. The current ARRL testing fee of \$15.00.
- 5. ALL persons taking an exam MUST have an FCC Federal Registration Number (FRN) and have that number with them at the test session to include on the test form. If you currently have an FCC license you already have an FRN. If you do not have an FRN you MUST register in the FCC CORES system – you will be issued an FRN upon registering. If you currently hold an FCC license and do not know your FRN you can look it up at the above link

No pre-registration is required for our sessions. Examinations are administered on a site by 9:00AM.
